File Input/Output with Code::Blocks

File I/O in Code::Blocks is very similar to how it was in Eclipse.

Start with your source file open, then click on the New File icon in the top left.



A drop down menu will open. Click on **Empty File**.

Your empty file will open in a new tab, and will have nothing in it. Go ahead and save it.

A window like this should pop up:
